The course fee for the 2024 Michael Fortune Residency is \$8995. This fee does not include timber and other materials which will be invoiced separately.

If you are offered a place on the programme you will be invoiced for a 25% non refundable deposit of \$2248.75 which is due for payment on 1st June 2023 with the balance of the course fee due for payment on 1st November 2023.

Refunds of course fees will only be made in accordance with the Centre for Fine Woodworking Refund Policy :

- By accepting a place on the Michael Fortune Residency Programme at the Centre for Fine Woodworking, a student enters a contract for the duration of the course. This contract means there is an obligation to pay the full course fee by 1st November 2023 and late payment will jeopardise your place on the course.
- There is no automatic right to a refund of course fees if a student changes his/her mind about attending the Centre for Fine Woodworking's Furniture Makers' Programme at any time
- Where exceptional circumstances necessitate withdrawal from the programme, the Centre for Fine Woodworking may, after consideration of the exceptional circumstances and timeframe, approve an appropriate refund less the deposit and an administration fee of \$350.
