- Links to website/Instagram/Facebook or any other platform which shows your work (if applicable)
- Proof of level attained if English is not your first language

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA:

The recipient of the 2024 Scholarship will have the full course fee of \$8995 paid for by the Centre for Fine Woodworking.

All materials, travel and accommodation will not be covered as part of this scholarship and will be the recipient's responsibility – please consider this before applying.

Please note that applications received from both professional and non-professional makers will be given equal consideration.

The scholarship is not awarded on the basis of financial hardship but purely on the merit of the project, the quality of the application, the technical challenge and achievability within the time frame.

The Selection Panel will look at all your supporting documentation (as outlined above), and you will need to clearly and fully demonstrate that your application considers the following :-

- Is the project achievable in the six week time frame – either to completion or to the point that it is resolved or you are able to complete the work at home?
- Is the project achievable based on your experience and skill level?
- Does your project take your work in a new direction or push yourself out of your comfort zone?

The selection panel will consider the following points:-

- Quality of the design proposal
- Technical challenge of the project
